

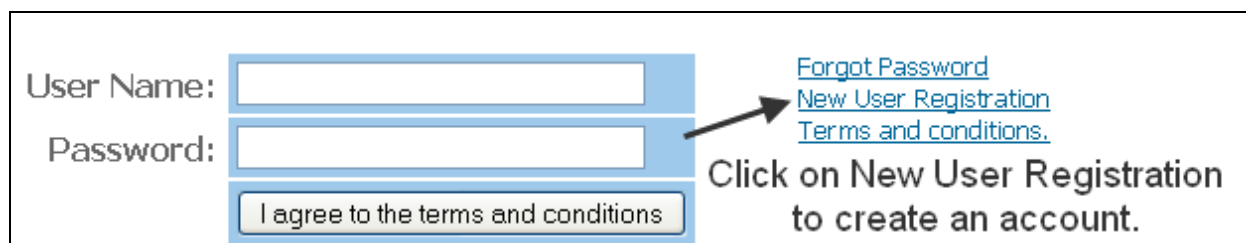
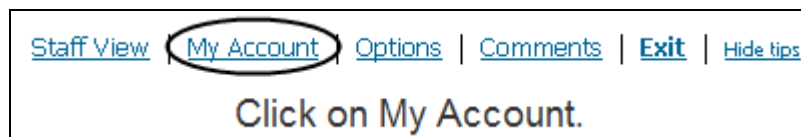
Setting Up Saved Searches

Would you like to save a search to run again later? Set up a Saved Search!

FirstSearch offers Saved Searches which allows you to save a search to run again at a later time.

Note: Saved Searches query a single database at a time. For thorough searches, set up Saved Searches in multiple databases.

Prior to saving a search, you need to create an account in FirstSearch.



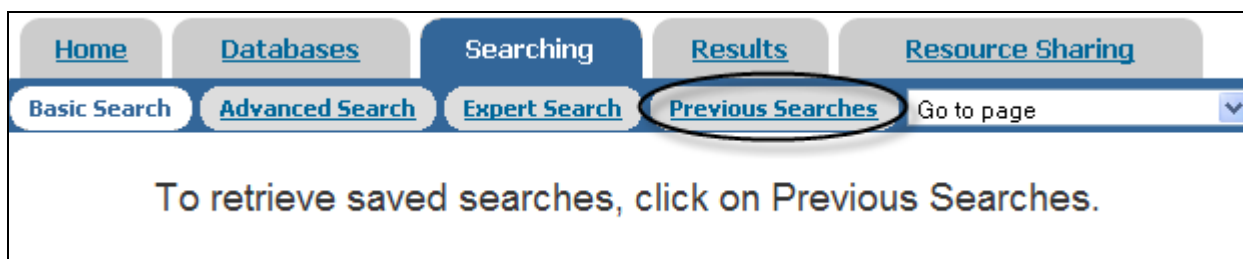
- Fill in the requested information to set up your personal FirstSearch Account.

NOTE: Neither the Jessie C. Eury Library nor CT are able to assist you with recovering your FirstSearch User Name and Password.

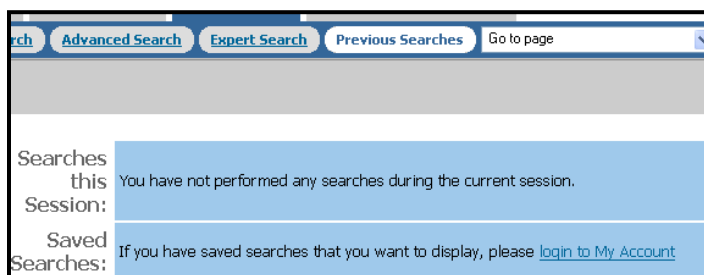
- Complete a search in the database of your choice.
- Click on **Save Search**.



- You will be prompted to log-in to My Account.
- You will then receive the message “Your search has been saved for later use.”

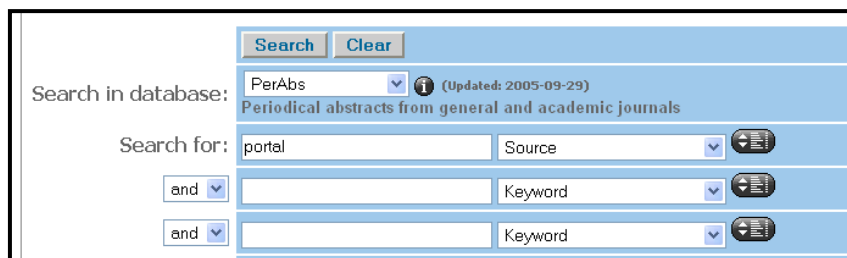


Setting Up Saved Searches



- You will be prompted to [login to My Account](#).
- Your saved searches will be displayed.

Note: If your favorite journal is indexed in a database that allows Saved Searches,



⇒ Complete an Advanced Search for the journal title in the Source field and then save the search.

Deleting Saved Searches

- To delete a Saved Search, log in to My Account and click Delete next to the appropriate search.
