

LINCOLN CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Lincoln Christian University, its Alumni Association, and its friends have established scholarship funds from which scholarships are made for the next school year. The scholarships are awarded based on academic achievement, commitment to ministry, and financial need. The amounts of the scholarships vary, depending on the funds available and the number of scholarships awarded. The funds may be used for any educational expense, unless restricted by the donor. One half of the total amount awarded will be disbursed per semester.

All applicants must be committed to Christian service. All undergraduate students with at least a 2.0 GPA and enrolled in at least 12 hours or graduate students with at least a 2.5 GPA and enrolled in at least 6 hours per semester are eligible to apply.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Complete and submit the application which must be **postmarked** on or before **March 15th**, 2012.
2. Complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Non-US citizens do not need to complete the FAFSA. Complete at www.fafsa.gov before March 15. Mail the signature page immediately (not required if PIN was used for student and/or parent). If planning to be married in 2012 after March 15, contact Nancy Siddens before completing the FAFSA.
3. Submit a full one-page essay that reveals your plans for specialized Christian Service.
